Saint John Henry Newman knew the importance of education. He spent his entire adult life connected to education. He began as an Oxford Don, but lost that position after his conversion to the Roman Catholic Church. He then taught religion classes to the Irish workers of his parish. He was asked to start the Irish University, and his series of lectures promoting the establishment of it, *The Idea of the University*, is considered a masterpiece of education. He later founded a school for boys in Birmingham, to give them a good Catholic education and prepare them for a university education.
